Plan improvements

The Board of Trustees of the St. Louis-Kansas City Carpenters Regional Health Plan recently approved the following benefit improvements to the plan.



Therapies for developmental delays approved June & August 2023

Retroactively effective January 1,2023, Speech Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Occupational Therapy are covered under the health plan for appropriately treating developmental delays. Previously, the plan excluded therapies as a treatment for developmental delays.



Breast pump purchase clarification approved June 2023

In the June 2023 Builder, it was announced that the purchase of breast pumps would be added as a benefit under the plan; however, shared coverage detail was not specific. Breast pumps will be allowed for purchase under the plan as follows:

One pump allowed <u>per live birth</u>, whether single or multiple birth, as well as out of network coverage for breast pump rentals for Premium Plan participants and dependents.



Dry needling approved October 2023

The health plan's Board of Trustees approved dry needling treatment guided by a professional physical therapist as a covered benefit under the health plan. A form of acupuncture, dry needling is a treatment that healthcare providers use for pain and movement issues associated with myofascial trigger points.

Important notes: Subject to prior authorization. Acupuncture is not a covered benefit under the Plan.



Augmentation speech devices approved October 2023

The Board approved adding augmentation speech devices as a covered benefit under the DME provisions of the plan, in conjunction with the developmental delay therapies that are now covered services.

By definition, an *augmentation speech device* is a device dedicated to transmitting or producing messages or symbols in a manner that compensates for the impairment and disability of a member with severe expressive communication disorders.





Qualifying clinical trials approved October 2023

The Board has updated the definition of *clinical trials* under the plan to include any life-threatening condition, subject to prior authorization, and only to cover amounts not paid by the trial.

Previously, consideration for coverage for qualifying clinical trials was limited to cancer-related treatment only.

SELF-PAY RATES

Qualified participants and dependents are allowed to continue coverage under the health plan by making monthly self-payments if they do not qualify through hours worked. Trustees have completed their annual review of these rates as included below and in the tables on the right:

No physician referral needed

There's a new way to access physical therapy benefits in Missouri. In August 2023, a new law went into effect in Missouri which allows anyone to schedule an appointment with a licensed physical therapist without the need for a physician's referral.

Patients must still provide proof of insurance for claims to be paid by your health plan, but this new law gives individuals seeking improved health outcomes the freedom to take charge of your health and wellbeing by directly accessing the expert care and guidance of skilled physical therapists.







Remember that seeing an in-network physical therapy provider will offer you the best benefits and the least out-of-pocket cost.

Life Events

When you have a new life event, such as a marriage or newborn baby, please make sure to notify our office as soon as possible <u>and</u> complete a new Enrollment Form. Documentation must be received in our office <u>within</u> <u>30 days</u> of a new life event for coverage to begin on the date of the event.

Maternity Leave

If you are a female participant and need to take time off work for delivery of a newborn baby, remember you are eligible to draw weekly short-term disability benefits as allowed by law.

Short-Term Disability forms may be found on **laborfunds.org**, as well as through our **Member Portal**.

Short-term disability benefits for live births do not apply to spouses or dependents.

Returning to Work after ST Disability

If you are a participant who has been out on shortterm disability but are able to return to work early before your period of disability is scheduled to end, let us know!

You are only eligible for short-term disability benefits for as long as your doctor indicates AND so long as you are not currently working.

You must call or email Participant Services to update your Return-to-Work date before you return to work.

Don't Pay Full Price: Maintenance Meds

Filling a 3-month supply of your long-term medication can help you save time, money and trips to the pharmacy. To reduce the cost of your long-term medications, prescriptions must be filled through Express Scripts mail order or through a Restricted Retail Pharmacy.

ANNUITY: AMENDMENT 4 APPROVED

summary of material modifications

Retroactively Effective 5/1/2019

The Annuity Fund Board of Trustees have approved updates to the St. Louis-Kansas City Carpenters Regional Annuity Fund. Section 3.03 has been deleted in its entirety and updated as outlined below.

Withdrawal of Benefits

To be eligible to request a distribution, a Participant must make a written application in a form acceptable to the Trustees and must satisfy one of the three following conditions:

- a. Attainment of Normal Retirement Age, which is the later of age 62 or the fifth (5th) anniversary of the date the individual became a Participant; or
- b. Attainment of at least age 55 with a 100% vested benefit in the Participant's Individual Account; or
- c. Any age, provided that the Participant is 100% vested in the Participant Individual Account and provided that the Participant has commenced a lifetime pension from the Carpenters Pension Trust Fund of St. Louis, the Carpenters Pension Trust Fund of Kansas City, the Carpenters Pension Fund of Illinois, or the Kansas Construction Trades Open End Pension Trust Fund.



STL PENSION PARTICIPANTS: 2023 TAX INFORMATION

If you received pension benefits from the Carpenters' Pension Trust Fund of St. Louis in 2023, please note that your **Form 1099-R** will be in the mail by January 31, 2023. This is the form you will need when filing your 2023 tax returns.

If you received a monthly Carpenters' Pension benefit and you turned 59-1/2 during the 2023 Tax Year (between 1/1/2023 and 12/31/2023), you will receive two (2) separate 1099-Rs.



One Form 1099-R will be for pension benefits received prior to age 59-1/2 and will be coded as "2" for Early Distribution in box number 7. The second Form 1099-R will be for your pension benefits received after age 59-1/2 and will be coded as "7" for Normal Distribution. When the amounts of both 1099-Rs are added together, it will equal the total amount of pension benefits you received during the 2023 Tax Year.

If you received a direct rollover in 2023, you will receive a 1099-R coded as a "G". This represents the direct rollover of a lump sum payment into an IRA or other qualified plan on a tax-deferred basis.



YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY CLAIMS EXPERT

Sometimes the unexpected happens. If accident or injury strikes and you're unable to work, do you know how you'll provide for your family? What is SSDI?

Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) is a payroll tax-funded, federal insurance program. A portion of the FICA taxes you pay are set aside for SSDI. This benefit is designed to provide you with income if you're unable to work due to a severe disability, until your condition improves, and guarantees income if your condition doesn't improve. Allsup and Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council are here to make sure you get the disability benefits you worked for and deserve.

Carpenters Wellness Center patients now have access to a new health portal.

What changes can you expect in the new Marathon Health Portal?

A new scheduling experience: the guided scheduling tool helps you select the right reason for your appointment, the most convenient time for your visit, and the method of meeting with your provider (telephonic, virtual or in-person) that works best for you.

Virtual care experience: after scheduling a virtual visit on the Marathon Health Portal, you will receive a link to fill out required forms or other requested information. You will also be able to check-in for your appointment. You will receive an email or text before your appointment time to join your virtual visit. This can also be done directly through the portal or Marathon Health app.

Opt-in access to your appointments: allow family members to view your upcoming and past appointments, as well as schedule appointments on your behalf, by accessing the "Family Permissions" section under your "Profile & Settings."

Link wearable devices: connect your Garmin or Fitbit wearable device by selecting the "Connect Your Device" button found under the "News" section of the Marathon Health Portal.
